

TREECS System Requirements

- 1) Minimum free disk space: 900 MB
- 2) Minimum RAM: 2 GB
- 3) MS Excel 2003 or later
- 4) Supported Operating Systems: Windows XP, Vista, or Windows 7
- 5) MS .NET Framework 3.5
- 6) Users should have "Full Control" permissions for all files in "C:\Prog Files\TREECS" as well as all subdirectories thereof. This can also be accomplished by setting permissions for the "Everyone Group".
- 7) Since the use of DOS 8.3 naming convention is strongly suggested, the user should probably have the system administrator that installs TREECS allow the user to create and use a TREECS project directory that adheres to the DOS 8.3 naming convention in a directory of one of the system drives (e.g. "D:\TrxProj").

Instructions for non-administrative users

We believe that the following procedure will allow the non-administrative user to be able to use TREECS:

Have an administrative IT person temporarily grant the user permission to install the TREECS software. The IT person should then logon to the user's system as that user (not as the IT administrator) and then install the TREECS software. The IT person should then log off of the system and reset the user's temporary install privileges. The IT person should then ensure that the user has full control permissions on the TREECS install directory and all subdirectories. The user should then be able to use TREECS normally.
